**Spiritual Lesson #1.** (Part Five) **The Mystery of JESUS.** What I am about to share with you, the antichrist does not want you to know. Please read Parts 1-4 first. Thanks. Look first in the <u>February Devotional Archives</u> (Thursday, 14 February 2008), on the <u>Spiritual Lessons</u> or <u>Mysteries Revealed</u> pages on the <u>eBlessings.us</u> web site. The spiritual warfare concerning the battle between the flesh and the spirit in humanity and his world begins in The Flesh Man versus the Spirit Man Book Series, the first book of which is: <u>iJac?</u>: is <u>JESUS</u> a <u>crackhead?</u> In this devotional I want to address the concept of Jesus being a flesh individual like you and I; and the concept that Jesus was a Spirit in the First Beginning, the

John Beginning. The devotional will be addressing how Jesus could be both Spirit at first, then flesh later and go bouncing back and forth; or could He?

Let me start by telling you that this Revelation about the Mystery of Jesus and the Mystery of The Christ first came to me about three years ago, around 2005. I began to ask a number of pastors and lay people if they knew about this concept, this possibility. About one-third had conceived it and the other two-thirds had not. But the ones who had heard of it would not share the conception or the Revelation because they said they people would not receive it, or they would not continue their fiscal responsibilities (hear: pay offerings / tithes). I was told if I brought it forward that I would run into controversy.

In January 2008 I published on the Internet the first devotional concerning the Christ being a Spirit which we should seek as this is on the Path of Righteousness which Jesus walked and on which we also walk; Jesus being our Example. Spiritual warfare broke out in the house. Satan was not happy and I was going to be informed about it. I continued to press on—as Dr. AC Brown would say, "You have to press the battle to the gates." I pressed on.

On some Sundays I speak at an elderly retirement home. As I was beginning the sermonette on the Mystery of the Righteousness of Jesus, with audience participation, I asked the question concerning how Jesus could be in Ancient Times and then at St. John's Beginning at the same time. The answer came quickly from among all the wise ones, "Jesus was flesh during Ancient Times and Jesus was Spirit in the Beginning. That's how." "Wow," I respond. "Yes, Christ Jesus was there both times both ways." Note I used Christ Jesus, not Jesus only.

As I reflected upon what was said on the way home, I thought, *Humm, that is a strong convincing argument against what I have been saying Lord; concerning what You have been telling me.* So as I thought about it and the immediate issue with this concept is "flesh." Flesh by its very nature is corrupt after Adam

and Eve. Before the Fall of Man, flesh was not corrupted (The Holy Spirit is letting me know that this is how Jesus could bear The Anointed One (The Christ); His flesh history drew upon the old flesh nature or the Original Flesh Nature, which was not corrupt.) and the Purity of the flesh nature of Mother Virgin Mary.

There was a penalty for their disobedience: the actual knowledge of knowing right from wrong, knowing good from evil; the "Knowledge of Good" and the "Knowledge of Evil." The second part of that thing, the "Knowledge of Evil" allowed man to be or become evil (hear: access evil things; conversely evil things accessing man (This is how unclean spirits can speak to your mind, your ears, your heart—your mind, ears, eyes, and hearts have accessed evil (hear: been exposed to it)). The concept is: that which one is innocent of, that which one is not a party to and that which (it) is not a party to one; as soon as one becomes knowledgeable of it, it has the power to consume one if: 1) one is not careful, 2) one is not knowledgeable of this concept, or 3) one is not ever-mindful of it. Knowledge is indeed power.

The Holy Spirit began to share with me once I got home and to the Bible. The scriptures "opened" for me to see: "Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption." 1 Corinthians 15:50 (KJ) This scripture was all I needed.

A) Flesh may move a certain way, but blood cannot move the way of flesh. (Don't ask me what that means, I am hearing it as I type. I am sure the explanation will come later.)

B) But this is what I was about to type: The Kingdom of God represents SPIRIT, Spirits, and a Spiritual Kingdom where no flesh resides; therefore Jesus as flesh could not go.

- C) And the Holy Spirit is telling me that The Christ was locked in the Jesus Flesh vessel and could not go to the Spiritual Kingdom—not as long as He was in the Flesh—and He was locked into the flesh at birth and released at death. This is amazing. Hallelujah!
- D) Jesus could not go from flesh to spirit to flesh. And the reason is: "neither doth corruption inherit incorruption" translated means Jesus as flesh carrying The Christ could not turn into spirit, because He was Spirit already (Spirit combined (hear: locked) in step with flesh, which He had to keep control of.) "But I tell you this, brethren, flesh and blood cannot [become partakers of eternal salvation and] inherit or share in the kingdom of God; nor does the perishable (that which is decaying) inherit or share in the imperishable (the immortal)." 1 Corinthians 15:50 (Amplified)
- E) Flesh was not created until many millennia after the First Beginning. What people like to do is start from the present and go back to the past. The more correct way to perceive the world is to start in the past and come forward into the future. If you start in the present and go back to the past, you can imagine Jesus as a man, then He magically, like a television show you have seen, vanishes and travels back as a spiritual human to the time in the First Beginning when flesh did not exist nor was ever created. But if you start in the past and move forward through time you can understand that originally as is now, has always been, and always will be—the Holy Father God and His Kingdom. After many millennia, humans were created along with space and time and the many other comforts of our puny human existence.
