"Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;"

Romans 3:25 (KJ)

The Mystery of our Righteousness - 9. Please read **Matthew 20:1-16** before proceeding. Thanks. (continued) Please touch your eyes and ask Christ to allow you to see and understand what you are about to read and allow the Holy Spirit to teach you what it all means. Listen carefully as the antichrist does not want you to know or understand this information. See Part One, <u>12 October 2008</u>.

This is for mature Christian Seekers: You nor I can do anything to obtain the righteousness of Father God but it be given from above through Jesus, Who is the Christ. There is nothing, you or I can do to obtain the Righteousness of Christ Jesus, except it be given from The Father. This my friend is GRACE. What am I saying? I am saying as you live your day and give up those wants and desires which you know are not acceptable in God's Eyes, we feel like we are more righteous—we feel like we earned it like the day laborers. When we go to church every time the doors are open, it makes us feel more righteous. When we see someone shouting in the spirit and we are not, we tend to feel less righteous. When we ... I can go on and on with this. **"That as sin hath reigned unto death,** (OLD TESTAMENT (hear: old covenant) (PHARISEE) THEOLOGY) **even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord.** (NEW TESTAMENT (hear: New Covenant) THEOLOGY)" **Romans 5:21** (KJ)

The point is this: the laborers in the field felt as though they desired more wages because of their efforts and emotions. People like to believe, (based on antichrist teachings) that if they have sacrificed those things they want and love, that this accounts towards them as faithfulness and therefore righteousness. They then hold this energy in their hearts and in their beings—in their souls. This same energy is used against LESS RIGHTEOUS Christians, much as the same way Pharisees of Ancient Times used their "righteousness" to say to others that their righteousnesses was not (in today's terms—not in the Religious Right; or holier than the next person) or equal to theirs. We are all Righteous through Christ Jesus—our Righteousnesses are equal. Paul brought you spiritual hierarchy from the institutional nature of the WHO? of the Pharisees! What!? Yes, listen and think. This will be discussed another time. I move on.

Remember, Jesus was bringing equality—SPIRITUAL EQUALITY. Heaven forbid! But yes, Jesus brings equality of RIGHTEOUSNESS to all—the Righteousness of the Father to all through His Beloved Christ and the shedding of the Blood of sinless Jesus. What is so important about all this if you do not receive understanding in this matter? The laborers felt like the deserved more for their efforts. People often associate their righteousness with their acts, deeds of faith, their faith—when our righteousness—our Righteousness of The Heavenly Father through Jesus, Who is the Christ.

"And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are." John 17:11 (KJ) (Remember to note this: "...keep through thine own name..." This will be revisited.)

Do not allow your emotions, unclean spirits, or the spirit of the antichrist to tell you or make you feel like you are righteousness—you MUST KNOW THAT YOUR RIGHTEOUSNESS IS IN JESUS. That is one of the myriad of reasons why He had to shed His BLOOD—the Price for our Righteousness. So when you do something wrong—and FEEL bad—lean on the Righteousness of Jesus. When You FEEL anything, know that you MUST REPLACE it with KNOWLEDGE. Our emotions will betray us. LISTEN: God is LOVE, He is NOT and EMOTION. He is a SPIRT, not emotion. Spirit is ACTION. Love is action—the action of the two greatest commandments—"And the second is like, namely this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these." Mark 12:31 (KJ)

To conclude, let me recap:

 Counting our works as our faith, does not count our works as our Righteousness—that is Christ Jesus. 2) Faith, obedience, works does not count towards our Righteousness; Christ Jesus is our Righteousness.

Remember the criminals on the cross—the one's "labor of faith" allowed him to be granted entrance into Heaven.

Let me give you this in a nutshell then expound on it. People often count our obedience to God as righteousness. "And it shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the LORD our God, as he hath commanded us." Deuteronomy 6:25 (KJ) Not true anymore, that is Old Covenant. Akin to that is thinking the mark of a person's righteousness is that they have wealth. Not true, this is also Old Covenant—"Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself." 1 Timothy 6:5 (KJ)– wealth is not godliness. Our righteousness (little "r") and our Righteousness (big "R") is that of Christ Jesus.
