EXCERPT FROM THE GOSPEL MIXTURE: THE FOUR IN ONE GOSPEL OF JESUS (pages 73-75 of 327; formatting changes due to Internet)

CHAPTER SEVEN

Jesus Ordains Twelve Apostles

12 **AND** it came to pass in those days, that he went out into a mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God. (Luke)

13 And when it was day, he (Luke) 13 calleth *unto him* whom he would: and they came unto him. (Mark) 13 He called *unto him* his disciples: and of them he chose twelve, (Luke) 14 and he ordained twelve, (Mark) 13

whom also he named apostles; (Luke) 14 that they should be with him, and that he might send them forth to preach, 15 and to have power to heal sicknesses, and to cast out devils: (Mark) 1 he gave them power against unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease. (Matthew)

2 Now the names of the twelve apostles are these; The first, Simon, (Matthew) 14 (whom he also (Luke) 16 surnamed (Mark) 14 Peter,) (Luke) 2 and Andrew his brother; James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother; (Matthew) 17 and he surnamed them Boanerges, which is, The sons of thunder: (Mark) 3 Philip, and Bartholomew; Thomas, and Matthew the publican; James the son of Alphaeus, and Lebbaeus, whose surname was Thaddaeus; (Judas the brother of James – Luke 6:16) 4 Simon the Canaanite, (Matthew) 15 called Zelotes, (Luke) 4 and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed him. (Matthew)

19 And they went into an house. (Mark) 17 And he came down with them, and stood in the plain, and the company of his disciples, and a great multitude of people out of all Judaea and Jerusalem, and from the sea coast of Tyre and Sidon, which came to hear him, and to be healed of their diseases; 18 and they that were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed. 19 And the whole multitude sought to touch him: for there went virtue out of him, and healed *them* all. (Luke)

(Luke 6:12-19; Mark 3:13-17, 19; Matthew 10:1-4)

Jesus' Teachings – Beatitudes

1 AND seeing the multitudes, he went up into a mountain: and when he was set, his disciples came unto him. (Matthew) 20 And he lifted up his eyes on his disciples, (Luke) 2 and he opened his mouth, and taught them, saying, 3 Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. (Matthew) 20 Blessed be ye poor: for yours is the kingdom of God. (Luke) 4 Blessed are they that mourn: for they shall be comforted. (Matthew) 21 Blessed are ye that hunger now: for ye shall be filled. Blessed are ye that weep now: for ye shall laugh. (Luke) 5 Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth. 6 Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled. 7 Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy. 8 Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God. 9 Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God. 10 Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. (Matthew) 22 Blessed are ye, when men shall hate you, and when they shall separate you from their company, and shall reproach you, and cast out your name as evil, (Luke) 11 revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake (Matthew) - 22 for the Son of man's sake. 23 Rejoice ve in that day, and leap for joy: (Luke) 12 and be exceeding glad: (Matthew) 23 for, behold, your reward is great in heaven: for in the like manner did their fathers unto the prophets.

(Luke) 12 So persecuted they the prophets which were before you. (Matthew)

(Matthew 5:1-12; Luke 6:20-23)

Jesus' Teachings – Similitudes

24 **BUT** woe unto you that are rich! For ye have received your consolation. 25 Woe unto you that are full! For ye shall hunger. Woe unto you that laugh now! For ye shall mourn and weep. 26 Woe unto you, when all men shall speak well of you! For so did their fathers to the false prophets. (Luke)

13 Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? It is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men. 14 Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. (Matthew) 33 No man, when he hath lighted a candle, putteth *it* in a secret place, neither under a bushel, but on a candlestick, that they which come in may see the light, (Luke) 15 and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. 16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven. (Matthew)
